**REFLECTION -ALL SAINTS**  
**The feast of the 'ordinary' Christian**

In many cities of the world you may visit the tomb of the Unknown Soldier. This commemorates the millions who were the ordinary soldiers who died, heroically and tragically, in war.

An altar to the unknown saint would be a fitting commemoration in our Churches for the millions of ordinary Christians and who lived lives of quiet, often strong and heroic sanctity.

We think this day of our unknown saints, known only to those whose lives they touched. We have been made who we are by their love and their faith.

For our grandparents, for our parents, first teachers of faith, first givers of love, we give thanks this day; For our family, brothers and sisters, and extended family, with whom we shared much of life, we give thanks this day; For teachers, priests, sisters, brothers, all who guided our schooling, often with little personal reward, we give thanks this day; And for others whose Christian life has influenced our own faith in God, we give thanks this day. They are canonised in the eyes of God: their shrine is in our hearts; and the lamp that honours them is the light of our Christian life.

This is their feast.  
 One day it will be your feast and mine.

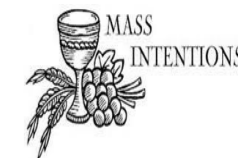
