Tuesday 17th March is St Patrick's Day. It is a holy day of obligation. Mass times are as follows: 16th March 6.00pm (vigil), 17th March 10.00am & 11.30am. On St. Patrick's Day we are asked to remember in our prayer those who have emigrated. Many of you reading this will no doubt have been touched by the sense of loss that comes with a loved one emigrating. There will be a collection taken up on all St. Patrick's day Masses for Irish emigrants/migrants. Funds raised through this collection will be used to support Irish citizens overseas.
