

EASTER BLESSINGS: In conjunction with the Parish Pastoral Council, Fr. Michael, Fr. Shajan and all the team of Holy Redeemer Parish, wish all of our parishioners and their families and friends (particularly those who have come home for Easter) every blessing in this holy season.

EASTER celebrates the central event of the Christian faith: the resurrection of Christ three days after his death by crucifixion. St. Paul wrote that, unless Christ rose from the dead, our faith is in vain (1 Corinthians 15:17). Through his death, Christ saved humankind from bondage to sin, and He destroyed the hold that death has on all of us; but it is His Resurrection that gives us the promise of new life, both in this world and the next.



HOLY COMMUNION - OUR EASTER DUTY: Because of the central importance of Easter to the Christian faith, the Catholic Church requires that all Catholics who have made their First Communion receive the Holy Eucharist sometime during the Easter season, which lasts through to Pentecost 50 days after Easter. (The Church also urges us to take part in the Sacrament of Confession before receiving this Easter communion.) This reception of the Eucharist is a visible sign of our faith and our participation in the Kingdom of God. Of course, although we should receive Holy Communion as frequently as possible; this 'Easter Duty" is simply the minimum requirement set by the Church.

ARCHBISHOP EAMONN MARTIN As Archbishop Eamon Martin takes on his added role of Apostolic Administrator of Dromore diocese, we wish him the grace and support he needs for this added duty and we will keep him in our prayers.

AS MONDAY IS A BANK HOLIDAY there will be no evening Mass. The Miraculous Medal Novena Prayers will be offered at 10.00am Mass.

A SPECIAL COLLECTION In addition to our normal parish collection, a special collection will be held at all Masses this weekend for Archbishop Eamon Martin and for the upkeep of the Priests of the Parish. Thank you for your generous support of our priests.
