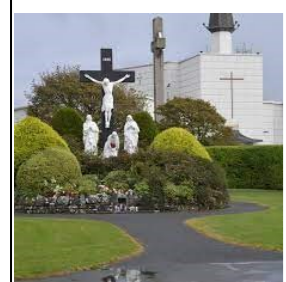


CHURCH GATE COLLECTION This weekend is in aid of St. Vincent De Paul. We thank you for your generosity.

ARCHDIOCESAN PILGRIMAGE TO LOURDES 2022 Archdiocesan Pilgrimage to Lourdes 2022 will take place this year from 26th September to 1st October.

The Pilgrimage will be operating through Marian Pilgrimages.

The fare is: * 750 euro per person sharing (Single Room Supplement 190 euro)

* 720 euro youth fare. The ongoing impact and uncertainty around the Covid-19 Pandemic means that this will be a different Pilgrimage. We will not be in a position to provide Medical and Nursing Support in the Accuei Notre Dame to Assisted Pilgrims as in prior years. Those Pilgrims intending to travel will need to be able to travel independently or to be accompanied by a family member/carer who can provide all of their care and support needs. All applicants will be required to complete a comprehensive booking form, which will include Medical information. Our Chief Medical Officer and his team will review this form prior to acceptance to travel. All applicants will need to provide proof of vaccination. While in Lourdes the Medical Team will be on call to serve the wider needs of our pilgrimage community and to oversee the implementation of our Covid Protocols, should the need arise.



Bookings can be made through the Dundalk Lourdes Committee, details of which are on a poster at the back of the Church.

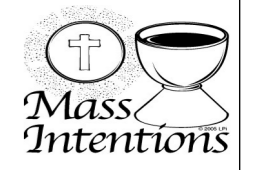
