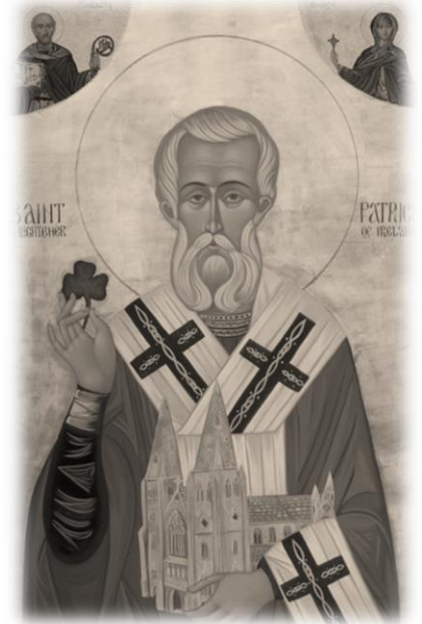

BULLETIN | 1ST DECEMBER | FIRST SUNDAY OF ADVENT

BAPTISMS: normally take place in:
