Stations of the Cross at 6.00pm-outdoor from St. Patrick's to St. Nicholas, Bridge Street.

HOLY SATURDAY: (No morning Mass)

Easter Vigil at 9.00pm followed by night prayer.

Masses as usual at 10.00am & 11.30.

After all Masses from Palm Sunday to Holy Thursday.

CHAPLET OF THE DIVINE MERCY will next take place this Sunday 2nd April 2023. St. Nicholas' Church, Bridge Street, Dundalk at 3pm, with confessions at 2.30pm. Featuring Holy Hour, the Divine Mercy Chaplet, Confessions and Anointing of the Sick. Come and receive God's blessing. All welcome.

Blessed palms will be available from the Church porch after all Masses.

HOLY WEEK begins this Sunday, (Palm Sunday) with the story of Jesus' triumphal entry into Jerusalem and the account of the Passion of Our Lord Jesus Christ. During Holy Week the Church celebrates the mysteries of salvation accomplished by Christ in the last days of His life on earth.

Holy Week is a very special week in our Church and faith journey with the Easter Triduum being the highlight of Holy Week. During these days we celebrate Christ's presence in the Eucharist; we reflect on His death on the cross; and we share in His Risen Life. We encourage you to come to these ceremonies, but in a particular way to come to the Easter Vigil on Saturday night when we renew our Baptism promises and our commitment to follow Jesus Christ.

CHRISM MASS Archbishop Eamon, along with the clergy of the diocese, will celebrate the Chrism Mass on Wednesday, 5th April at 7.00pm in St Patrick's Cathedral, Armagh. All are welcome. In particular, an invitation to attend is extended to families and schools in the diocese with children who will make their Confirmation this year.
