All are welcome. **Prayer to St Oliver Plunkett**: Glorious Martyr, St Oliver, who willingly gave your life for your faith, help us also to be strong in faith. May we be loyal like you to the See of Peter. By your intercession and example, may all hatred and bitterness be banished from the hearts of Irish men and women. May the peace of Christ reign in our hearts, as it did in your heart, even at the moment of your death. Pray for us and for Ireland. Amen. 'God knows it is **not force nor might,** Not brave nor warlike band. Not shield and spear, not dint of sworde, That must convert the land; It is

the blood of Martyrs shed, It is that noble traine, That fight with word and not with sworde, And Christ their capitaine.' *Poem published at the time of the Martyrdom at Tyburn of St. Edmund Campion SJ in December 1581, almost exactly a century before St. Oliver's death.*
