New Missal. Congregational cards provided for the new missal are now available. The new Missal will come into use from 10th September.

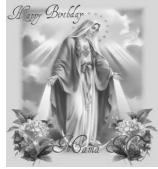

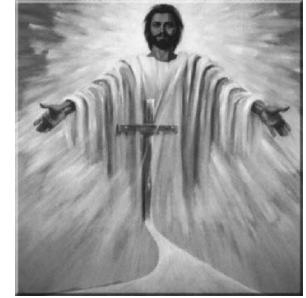

ST. PATRICIA'S PRAYER & MEDITATION GROUP:

John Main OSB (1926-1982) was a Roman Catholic Benedictine monk and priest who presented a way of Christian meditation which utilised a prayer-phrase or mantra. Main's teaching was simple: sit still and upright for a minimum of 20 and a maximum of 30 minutes, close your eyes and silently recite the prayer-phrase (mantra). The prayer-phrase is a sacred word or phrase which is repeated continually.
