- Can our quality of Liturgy be improved?** (*eg; made more prayerful*).
- Can we enable more participation?**
- Is there a schedule that provides a good choice of Mass times?** (*across the area as a whole*)
- Can our Mass schedules be covered with the increasingly limited number of priests?**

POPE'S HOLIDAY: Pope Benedict will spend the summer holiday at Castel Gandolfo, a tiny hilltop village overlooking Lake Albano, just 15 miles south east of Rome. The town has been the traditional holiday spot for Popes since the 15th century. But Pope Benedict's summer will not be overly relaxed. He will still greet pilgrims every Sunday with his noontime Angelus address, and has a trip to World Youth Day in Spain planned for mid-August and a September pilgrimage to his homeland of Germany. He also intends to use his stay at Castel Gandolfo to finish his three-volume biography of Jesus.
