THE PARISH LIST OF THE DEAD

The November Dead List of deceased family members and friends and contributions should be returned to the Sacristan of the Church or the Parochial House.

The November Dead List will be displayed in the Sanctuary of the Church during November.

'It is a holy & wholesome thought to pray for the dead'.

1. From 12 O' clock noon on 1st Nov until midnight all who have confessed, received Holy Communion, and prayed for the Pope's intentions (one Our Father and Hail Mary, or any other prayer of one's choice) can gain one plenary indulgence by visiting a church or oratory, and there reciting one Our Father and Apostle's Creed This indulgence is applicable only to the souls departed.

Confessions may be made at any time within the week preceding or the week following 1st Nov.

Holy Communion may be received on any day from 1st—8th Nov.

2. The faithful who visit a cemetery and pray for the dead may gain a plenary indulgence applicable only to the Holy Souls on the usual conditions, once per day from 1st—8th Nov.
