


## PARISH OF THE HOLY REDEEMER DUNDALK



EASTER BLESSINGS: In conjunction with the Parish Pastoral Council, Fr. Mark, Fr. Maciej, Fr. Stephen, Fr. Peter and all the team of Holy Redeemer Parish, wish all of our parishioners and their families and friends (particularly those who have come home for Easter) every blessing in this Holy Season.

**EASTER** celebrates the central event of the Christian faith: the resurrection of Christ three days after his death by crucifixion. St. Paul wrote that, unless Christ rose from the dead, our faith is in vain (1Corinthians 15:17). Through his death, Christ saved humankind from bondage to sin, and He destroyed the hold that death has on all of us; but it is His Resurrection that gives us the promise of new life, both in this world and the next.

HOLY COMMUNION - OUR EASTER DUTY: Because of the central importance of Easter to the Christian faith, the Catholic Church requires that all Catholics who have made their First Communion receive the Holy Eucharist sometime during the Easter season, which lasts through to Pentecost 50 days

after Easter. (The Church also urges us to take part in the Sacrament of Confession before receiving this Easter communion.) **Divine Mercy Sunday** This reception of the Eucharist is a visible sign of our faith St. Nicholas' Church, Dundalk and our participation in the Kingdom of God. Of course,
