RE-OPENING OF CHURCHES FOR PUBLIC CELEBRATION OF THE LITURGIES –

MONDAY MAY 10th:- On behalf of Fr. Shajan and myself we wish to welcome all our Parishioners back to public worship and look forward to your participation as a community once again. Fr. Michael.

Guidelines for our Church re-opening on Monday 10th May for Public Mass and Devotions are as follows

1. The dispensation from the Sunday and Holy Day of Obligations is extended for the time being.
2. The signs of limited seating must be adhered to, as social distancing must be observed, however a family from the same household can all sit together.
3. Signage in the Church must be followed.
4. Face masks may be worn.
5. Hands must be sanitised.
6. Respiratory etiquette must be observed at all times.
7. Where possible stewards will be on hand to show you to your seat.
8. Sit only in designated areas.
9. Communion to be received on the hand.
10. One way system in coming forward to receive Holy Communion.
11. Extraordinary Ministers of the Eucharist will wear face coverings while distributing Holy Communion.
12. Sunday collections for the present will not be taken up in the normal manner. Supervised collection baskets will be placed at the Church doors while leaving the Church and we ask that you kindly place your offerings into these baskets.
13. Please take Parish Weekly Bulletins home with you, do not leave them in the Church.
14. Kindly observe social distancing outside the Church. Please do not congregate.

BAPTISMS are being conducted fortnightly at 12:00 noon on a Saturday and at 1.00pm on a Sunday (these times may change if a funeral is taking place). Call to the parish office to arrange a day and time for the Baptism. Please give at least one month's notice. Please note the maximum in attendance is ten, this includes the baby, parents, Godparents and Priest. We welcome into our Christian community those recently baptised: Saoirse Mary McElroy.
