#### ABOUT THE YEAR FOR PRIESTS?

On the Feast of the Sacred Heart of Jesus (19 June) – Pope Benedict XVI launched a “Year for Priests” in celebration of the 150th anniversary of the birth of St John Vianney (the Curé of Ars). St John Vianney is the patron saint of parish priests and is renowned for his dedication to his priestly ministry through his care for his parishioners and passion for helping them rekindle the fire of their faith.

In launching this Year for Priests, Pope Benedict was not trying to exalt priests by having a special celebration for them.
