First Class Relic of Blessed Carlo Acutis, to visit St Patrick's Cathedral, Armagh in this the 150th year since the Dedication of the Cathedral A first class relic of Blessed Carlo will visit the Cathedral from Sunday 11th – Tuesday 13th June 2023. Blessed Carlo was beatified by Pope Francis in Assisi in October 2020. His friends remember him as a young dreamer, service-oriented and full of charisma. He died in 2006, at only 15 years of age, after a battle with leukemia. His life may have been short but it made a huge impact. Recently, in the process for the teenager's beatification, his tomb became a real pilgrimage site.
