New guidelines for the celebration of Public Mass and Devotions are as follows:

1. The dispensation from the Sunday and Holy Day of Obligations is extended for the time being.
2. Please do not attend on any day that you are feeling unwell.
3. Our Church will be sanitised after each Mass.
4. The signs of limited seating must be adhered to, as social distancing must be observed, however a family from the same household can all sit together.
5. Signage in the Church must be followed.
6. The use of face coverings is strongly recommended.
7. Hands must be sanitised.
8. Respiratory etiquette must be observed at all times.
9. Where possible stewards will be on hand to show you to your seat.
10. Sit only in designated areas. Each section has it's own entrance/exit. Not more than 50 people in each section.
11. Strictly no movement of people between sections before, during or after Mass.
12. Communion to be received on the hand.
13. One way system in coming forward to receive Holy Communion.
14. Extraordinary Ministers of the Eucharist will wear face coverings while distributing Holy Communion.
15. Sunday collections for the present will not be taken up in the normal manner. Supervised collection baskets will be placed at the Church doors while leaving the Church and we ask that you kindly place your offerings into these baskets.
16. Please take Parish Weekly Bulletins home with you, do not leave them in the Church.
17. Kindly observe social distancing outside the Church. Please do not congregate.

As we have returned to the celebration of public Masses, emphasis is on good hygiene, respecting distance and cough etiquette. Our strength as a community lies in our solidarity. No one is safe until everyone is safe. We need to mind each other and may the Lord bless all our best efforts.

SUMMER DUES 2020 Will be collected over the coming weeks. These dues are for the upkeep of the priests who serve this parish. Dues books and envelopes are available for collection in the Sacristy. Over the past year there has been a decline in the number of our due's collectors and unfortunately, we have been unsuccessful obtaining new volunteers. In light of this, in the areas where there is no collector we will be distributing an envelope to each household asking them to return same, with their donation to the Sacristy/Parochial House or to person who delivered the envelope to them. Your co-operation with this new method of dues collection is greatly appreciated. We welcome your continued support in these difficult times ahead. Thank you.

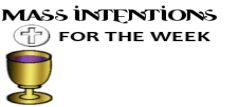

A SECOND COLLECTION will be taken up at all Masses this weekend to build up parish funds for future maintenance.

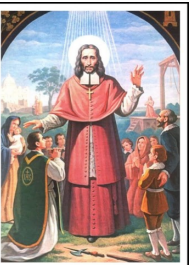
REDEEMER SCHOOLS – SACRAMENTS OF FIRST HOLY COMMUNION AND CONFIRMATION
