CHURCH GUIDELINES

WITH THE LIFTING OF MOST OF THE RESTRICTIONS SURROUNDING THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC. The continuation of the following protective measures is recommended by The Bishops Conference to ensure the safety and wellbeing of the vulnerable or anxious members of our congregation:

1. The continued wearing of face coverings inside Church buildings.
2. Weekly Parish Bulletins to be taken home after Mass. Please do not leave on Church seats.
3. Good sanitizing and cleaning arrangements.
4. Suspension of a handshake as the Sign of Peace.
5. Holy Communion to be received in the hand.
6. Holy water to be used in asperges but not yet restored to fonts for communal use at the entrances to Church buildings. We will continue to take care to provide appropriate protection and reassurance to all involved in Church activities.



Wednesday 17th March is St Patrick's Day. It is a Holy Day of obligation. Mass times are as follows: **16th March 6.00pm (vigil), 17th March 10.00am & 11.30am.** Please note that there will be no Stations of the Cross on Wednesday 16th March due to the Vigil Mass for St. Patrick. On St. Patrick's Day we are asked to remember in our prayers those who have emigrated. Many of you reading this will no doubt have been touched by the sense of loss that comes with a loved one emigrating. The collection taken up on all St. Patrick's day Masses for Irish emigrants/migrants. Funds raised through this collection will be used to support Irish citizens overseas.



A SECOND COLLECTION will be taken up at all Masses next weekend to build up parish funds for future maintenance.

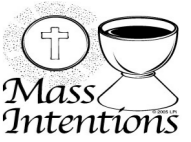
