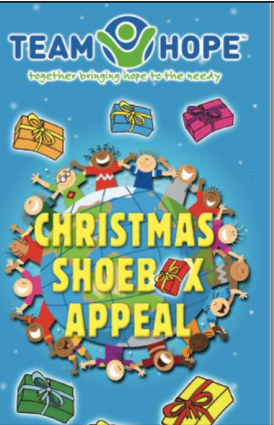
**Little Flower Prayer Group:** Meeting on Wednesday at 11.00am.
