MISSION APPEAL Missionary Fr. Sean Dempsey of the Comboni Missionaries will be speaking at all Masses next weekend **20th/21st November** and making an appeal in aid of their missionary work. Donation envelopes will be provided at the back of the Church.

The Comboni Missionaries was founded by St Daniel Comboni. St. Daniel was born in Limoni in 1831 not far from Verona where he was ordained in 1854. He went to the Sudan in 1857. It was a very difficult Mission and many of his companions died. He returned to Italy and founded the Comboni Missionaries of Priests and Brothers in 1867 and the Comboni Sisters in 1872 so that his missionary work would not die with him. He died in Khartoum in 1881. His motto was "save Africa through Africa". He saw the Africans as protagonists of their own evangelization and development. As Comboni Missionaries that is what we are doing today training teachers, priests and sisters to carry on his dream and be missionaries to other nations.

PILGRIMAGE TO THE INTERNATIONAL EUCHARISTIC AND MARIAN SHRINE IN KNOCK.

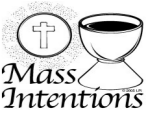
