RSA'S CHECK IT FITS The RSA's Check it Fits service is coming County Louth this July and will be visiting Tesco Extra, Donore Road, Drogheda on Tuesday 18th July and Smyth's Toys, Dundalk Retail Park on Wednesday 19th July from 10am to 5.30pm each day. Experts in child car seat safety will on hand to offer advice on the different types of seats available, how to fix any problem, demonstrate how to fit the restraint correctly and to answer any queries you may have. Travelling by car can potentially be one of the most dangerous things a baby or child is likely to do each day, so parents and guardians should ensure that their



small passengers are as well protected as possible by having the proper child car seat for their height and weight correctly installed in their vehicle. No appointment is necessary, and the free checks are open to all makes and models of cars and child car seats. Don't let your child be a statistic, get your child car seat checked.
