



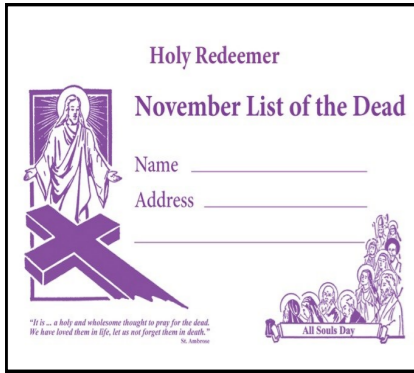

ANNIVERSARY MASS BOOK 2021:

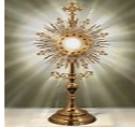
