Today we celebrate the Solemnity of Corpus Christi – the feast of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ and the summit of the Church’s life. 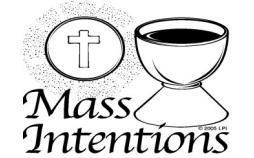
