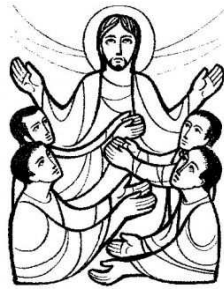


# PARISH OF THE HOLY REDEEMER, DUNDALK

**Vocations Sunday** is next Sunday the **26th April**, there will be a **special collection** held for Diocesan Education.

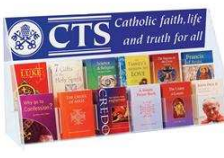

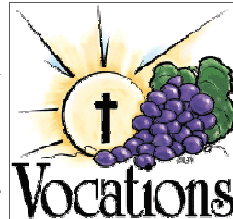
