**A NEW TRANSLATION OF THE MASS:** Starting this weekend, our parish will be preparing for some changes in the words of the Mass which will be brought into permanent use on the first Sunday of Advent, 27th November 2011. The changes are needed for a number of reasons and have come about after a lengthy period of deliberation. On a very practical note, cards are available from today which show exactly the changes in the peoples parts. **Please note, these are for church use only. Please do not remove.** Over the coming months we will try to help everyone to become more familiar with these developments.

**IMPROVING THE QUALITY OF OUR CELEBRATION OF THE MASS:** In conjunction with other parishes, we are beginning a consultation about the times of Masses in our parish and those in the Dundalk area. Some things to consider are; Can our quality of Liturgy be improved?

(eg; *made more prayerful*) Can we enable more participation? Is there a schedule that provides a good choice of Mass times? Can our Mass schedules be covered with the increasingly limited number of priests? This is a delicate issue but we would ask people to give it serious consideration.
