Trócaire Emergency Appeal Collection.

Saturday 28th/Sunday 29th August.

Trócaire has been working in Pakistan for more than twenty years, which means they have been well placed to respond quickly to this disaster and get help quickly to where it is needed most. Cecil Dunne, Trócaire's emergency officer in Pakistan says the situation is really desperate for survivors: "Floodwaters have washed away people, homes, bridges, water systems and medical facilities. Survivors have been left with nothing: no homes, no livestock. Yet more rain continues to fall" Trócaire is already supporting another 10,000 survivors with food, water, water purification tablets, cooking utensils, high energy biscuits for children and sanity supplies to vulnerable families.
