TODAY WE CELEBRATE PENTECOST SUNDAY: Pentecost is part of that great plan of God, the heart of God, to gather us all together. Guidelines for our Church re-opening for Public Mass and Devotions are as follows

- The dispensation from the Sunday and Holy Day of Obligations is extended for the time being.
- The signs of limited seating must be adhered to, as social distancing must be observed, however a family from the same household can all sit together.
- Signage in the Church must be followed.
- Face masks may be worn.
- Hands must be sanitised.
- Respiratory etiquette must be observed at all times.
- Where possible stewards will be on hand to show you to your seat.
- Sit only in designated areas.
- Communion to be received on the hand.
- One way system in coming forward to receive Holy Communion.
- Extraordinary Ministers of the Eucharist will wear face coverings while distributing Holy Communion.
- Sunday collections for the present will not be taken up in the normal manner. Supervised collection baskets will be placed at the Church doors while leaving the Church and we ask that you kindly place your offerings into these baskets.
- Please take Parish Weekly Bulletins home with you, do not leave them in the Church.
- Kindly observe social distancing outside the Church. Please do not congregate.
