universal call to Mission of all the baptized. They will be invited to contribute what they can to support the development and growth of young Churches internationally. Mission Sunday is celebrated by every Church worldwide, including the poorest. This special Sunday in October provides Catholics with the opportunity to unite with their missionary sisters and brothers overseas, and to recommit themselves to bringing the Joy of the Gospel to everyone they meet in their daily lives at home and at work.

This years theme is guided by the scriptural quote, "You shall be my witnesses." (Acts 1:8). In selecting this theme, Pope Francis reminds the faithful that every baptized Christian is called to be a witness to Christ. By imitation of Him who was sent by the Eternal Father, we, too, are sent to witness to the nations the presence of God's Kingdom in our midst.

A SECOND COLLECTION will be taken up at all Masses this weekend in aid of World Mission Sunday. For those of you who may wish to make your own private donation to this cause, donation envelopes will be available at the doors of the Church, which you can avail of. Thank you.
