The November Dead List Envelopes for deceased family members and friends are now available at the back of the church. Completed lists & offerings should be placed in a sealed envelope and returned to the Sacristan of the Church or the Parochial House. (Please think of taking some for neighbours or friends who cannot attend Mass). The November Dead List will be recorded in a book of remembrance in the sanctuary of the church during November, & Masses will be offered on All Souls Day (2nd November) & throughout the year. November is a special month in which we remember our departed relatives and friends. We remember them through our personal, family

and community prayer, by praying for them at liturgies and visiting a cemetery.

A SPECIAL MASS OF REMEMBRANCE for deceased relatives and friends of the Parish who died in the last year will be celebrated on Monday 2nd November at 7.30p.m. All are welcome.

PLENARY INDULGENCE: From 12 O' clock noon on 1st November until midnight all who have confessed, received Holy Communion, and prayed for the Pope's intentions (one Our Father and Hail Mary, or any other prayer of one's choice) can gain one plenary indulgence by visiting a church or oratory, and there reciting one Our Father and Apostle's Creed. This indulgence is applicable only to the souls departed. Confessions may be made at any time within the week preceding or the week following 1st November. Holy Communion may be received on any day during that time. **In addition**, the faithful who visit a cemetery and pray for the dead may gain a plenary indulgence applicable only to the Holy Souls on the usual conditions, (see above) once per day from 1st - 8th November.

November Month of the Holy Souls: Many people choose to abstain from alcohol for the month of November and offer this prayerful act in honour of their deceased loved ones and for someone they know or love with an addiction. You can do likewise! Take the SHORT-TERM pledge for November.

POPE CANONIZES MARRIED COUPLE: At an outdoor Mass in St. Peter's Square on last Sunday, Pope Francis canonized the parents of St. Thérèse of Lisieux, Saints Louis Martin (1823-94) and Marie-Azélie Guérin Martin (1831-77). This is the first time that a married couple have been officially proclaimed as saints together at the same ceremony. In his homily the pope said that "Louis Martin and Marie-Azélie Guérin practiced Christian service in the family, creating day by day an environment of faith and love which nurtured

the vocations of their daughters, among whom was Saint Therese of the Child Jesus." We pray for all families and that the Holy Spirit may guide the Synod of the Family that is finishing in Rome this weekend. May the intercession of Saints Louis and Marie-Azélie Martin help us all.

St. Gerard's Novena was a great success this year, with hundreds of people attending the daily prayers in our Church. There were many petitions for serious issues and many have received great comfort from the grace of their prayer. Thanks to everyone who helped make it happen. We encourage people who did attend the Novena, but who may not be regular church-goers to use the Novena as a starting point for coming back to Mass more often.
