AROUND THIS TIME: 1st March, Feast of St. David; patron saint of Wales, where he was abbot and bishop in the sixth century. Several Irish saints were his pupils and he influenced monastic development in Ireland. He died around 601. **5th March, Feast of St. Kieran.** Kieran of Saigir was born in Co. Cork. He is numbered among the pre-Patrician saints of Ireland. After being baptised and later ordained priest and bishop on the Continent, he returned to Ossory, where he lived as a hermit. Disciples soon joined him and Saigir became a well-known monastery.
