Celebrating our Pentecostal faith in the Eucharist, we continue to be a vibrant, inclusive, faith community, in the Spirit of our loving Redeemer.

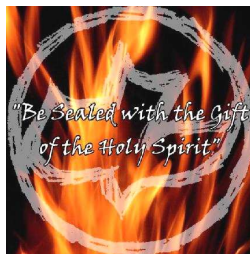

THE SACRAMENT OF CONFIRMATION will be celebrated in our Church at the 11.30am Mass. (Please note there will be no 12.30pm Mass) Celebrant: Cardinal Sean Brady. Confirmation celebrates the full outpouring of the Holy Spirit on a baptised person, completing and strengthening the grace given by the Spirit in Baptism. It marks the Christian as a follower of Christ and a full member of the Church. In our parish, children normally celebrate Confirmation in Sixth Class, with much of the preparation being carried out in school, therefore, it is appropriate to acknowledge the great work and dedication of the teachers and staff. This is always a very happy occasion for our parish too as we see the next generation of Catholics come forward. Please continue to keep them in your prayers.
