**Today 27th December we celebrate the Feast of the Holy Family of Jesus Mary and Joseph:** The Holy Family is seen as the model for the human family, the religious community, and the Church itself. The celebration of the Incarnation has brought us to see God's closeness. In the Holy Family we see the ordinariness of the life of Jesus, the simple acceptance by Mary and Joseph of the marvels of God. In the daily life of family and community we can touch the divine, we can come close to God. But we have to learn to live centred on God, with respect and love for each other.

On Monday 28th December we celebrate the Feast of the Holy Innocents, Martyrs: The flight into Egypt and the massacre of the Holy Innocents make manifest the opposition of darkness to the light: "He came to his own home, and his own people received him not." Christ's whole life was lived under the sign of persecution. His own share it with him. Jesus' departure from Egypt recalls the exodus and presents him as the definitive liberator of God's people.

On Friday 1st January we celebrate the Solemnity of Mary, the Holy Mother of God. May Mary show us in her Son, the way of peace, and enlighten our vision, so that we can recognise Christ's face in the face of every human person, the heart of peace.
