




SOLEMNITY OF ST PETER AND ST PAUL

On June 29th the Church celebrates the feast day of Sts. Peter & Paul. As early as the year 258, there is evidence of an already lengthy tradition of celebrating the solemnities of both Saint Peter and Saint Paul on the same day. Together, the two saints are

the founders of the See of Rome, through their preaching, ministry and martyrdom there.

Celebrant will be Cardinal Sean Brady and all visiting priests are welcome to concelebrate. We will be remembering in prayer the Ordinations
