**AS MONDAY 31ST OCTOBER IS A BANK HOLIDAY** there will be no evening Mass. The Miraculous Medal Novena Prayers will be offered at 10.00am Mass. Originally, of course Halloween meant the eve of the holy day, referring to All Saints, dressing up as a 'saint' might prove to be more true to the original meaning behind the feast.

**TUESDAY 1ST NOVEMBER IS THE SOLEMNITY OF ALL SAINTS - A HOLY DAY OF OBLIGATION:** The ultimate object of the veneration of the Saints is 'The glory of God' and the sanctification of man and woman by conforming one's life fully to the divine will and by imitating the virtue of those who were pre-eminent disciples of the Lord.

**WEDNESDAY 2ND NOVEMBER IS ALL SOULS DAY.** From the very earliest days of the Christian religion, the memory of the dead has been honoured with great respect. Because it is a holy and wholesome thought to pray for the dead, the church offers primarily the celebration of the holy mass and other pious exercises such as, prayers for the dead, works of mercy and indulgences
